November 9 <sup>th</sup>	Matthew 6:20-21	20 But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.  21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

November 23 <sup>rd</sup>	Jeremiah 17:9	The heart is deceitful above all things and beyond cure. Who can understand it?
November 30 <sup>th</sup>	1 John 5:11-12	11 And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.  12 He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
December 7 <sup>th</sup>	1 John 5:13	13 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.

January 11 <sup>th</sup>	John 3:16-17	16 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.  17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.

January 19 <sup>th</sup>	Psalm 1:1-3	1 Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers.  2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.  3 He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers.

February 1 <sup>st</sup>	Psalm 1:4-6	4 Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.  5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous.  6 For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.
February 8 <sup>th</sup>	Romans 3:23  Romans 6:23	for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,  For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
February 16 <sup>th</sup>	Romans 10:9-10	9 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.  10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.
February 22 <sup>nd</sup>	<b>Review all 7 verses</b>	
March 1 <sup>st</sup>	Matthew 6:33-34	33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.  34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.
