## 5<sup>th</sup> GRADE BIBLE VERSES (Month-by-Month Breakdown)

### August

28<sup>th</sup> Psalm 1:1-2 - Blessed is the man who does not walk in the counsel of the wicked or stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of mockers. But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night.

### September

4<sup>th</sup> Psalm 1:3-4 - He is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither. Whatever he does prospers. Not so the wicked! They are like chaff that the wind blows away.

11<sup>th</sup> Psalm 1:5-6 - Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of the righteous. For the LORD watches over the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.

18<sup>th</sup> Ephesians 4:29 - Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.

25<sup>th</sup> James 1:1-3 - James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, To the twelve tribes scattered among the nations: Greetings. Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance.

### October

1<sup>st</sup> James 1:4-5 - Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking Anything. If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him.

8<sup>th</sup> James 1:6-8 - But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That man should not think he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does.

16<sup>th</sup> James 1:9-10 - The brother in humble circumstances ought to take pride in his high position. But the one who is rich should take pride in his low position, because he will pass away like a wild flower.

**23<sup>rd</sup>** James 1:11-12 - For the sun rises with scorching heat and withers the plant; its blossom falls and its beauty is destroyed. In the same way, the rich man will fade away even while he goes about his business. Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

**29<sup>th</sup>** James 1:13-15 - When tempted, no one should say, 'God is tempting me.' For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; but each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire, he is dragged away and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.

### November

**6<sup>th</sup>** James 1:16-18 - Don't be deceived, my dear brothers. Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. He chose to give us birth through the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of all he created.

**13<sup>th</sup>** James 1:19-20 - My dear brothers, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry, for man's anger does not bring about the righteous life that God desires.

**20<sup>th</sup>** James 1:21-22 - Therefore, get rid of all moral filth and the evil that is so prevalent and humbly accept the word planted in you, which can save you. Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

### December

**4<sup>th</sup>** James 1:23-24 - Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like a man who looks at his face in a mirror and, after looking at himself, goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like.

**11<sup>th</sup>** James 1:25-26 - But the man who looks intently into the perfect law that gives freedom, and continues to do this, not forgetting what he has heard, but doing it - he will be blessed in what he does. If anyone considers himself religious and yet does not keep a tight rein on his tongue, he deceives himself and his religion is worthless.

17<sup>th</sup> James 1:27 - Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.

### January

15<sup>th</sup> John 1:1-2 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning.

22<sup>nd</sup> John 1:3-4 - Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. In him was life, and that life was the light of men.

28<sup>th</sup> John 1:5-6 - The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it. There came a man who was sent from God: his name was John.

### February

5<sup>th</sup> John 1:7-8 - He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all men might believe. He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.

11<sup>th</sup> John 1:9-10 - The true light that gives light to every man was coming into the world. He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him.

19<sup>th</sup> John 1:11-12 - He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God

26<sup>th</sup> John 1:13-14 - children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God. The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

### March

5<sup>th</sup> Romans 3:23 - For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God

John 3:3 - In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."

**11<sup>th</sup>** Romans 5:8 - But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

**25<sup>th</sup>** Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 5:12 - Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all men, because all sinned-

**1<sup>st</sup>** Romans 10:9-10 - That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.

**16<sup>th</sup>** Romans 10:11-13 - As the Scripture says, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame." For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile - the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
