~ Parking Lot Problems ~

### Free Flu Vaccines

Once again, we'll be having our Free Flu Vaccine Clinic here at the school October 14th. More information will follow as it gets closer. The flu shots this year will be a combination of the regular seasonal flu and the H1N1. If you have any questions please speak with Miss Carlson, our school nurse.

### The Flu Season & You

The Department of Health has provided tips on what to do to help protect your child and others from catching the flu.

- \* Get vaccinated
- \* Prevent the spread of germs
- \* Stay home if you are sick

In all of our classrooms we are washing surfaces with bleach/water to kill germs, making sure kids either wash their hands with soap and water or using hand sanitizer, and discussing and practicing covering their nose and mouth when coughing and sneezing.

**If your child has a fever you must keep them home until they are fever free for 24 hours WITHOUT fever reducing medicine. This is very important to keep flu from spreading.**

You do NOT need a doctor's note to return to school unless your child has missed 5 consecutive days of school. You do need to send a note from you so that we have a written reason they were out of school. You can either send a hand written note or an e-mail.

### School Handbooks
